We are called into a dying and risen way that is the path we take in following Jesus. We celebrate the unique act of Jesus on the cross and in the resurrection and are challenged again to die to self and embrace our status as those who are 'raised with Christ'.

Everyone worships something. This term we want to examine again the biblical theme of idolatry and true worship. It could be said that the following of

other gods is the foundational human sin according to the Bible- the ten commandments begin with the instruction that 'you shall have no other god beside me'. And yet we are so easily drawn into, seduced and distracted by alternative controlling ideas and dreams...fashioning our own good news to lead us to our own bespoke heavens. Jesus calls us back to our Father, in Christ and through the Holy Spirit. He invites us to true worship.

As we approach Easter, we consider two statements from John's gospel that hinge on the word 'Unless'. These statements help us to think about the meaning of

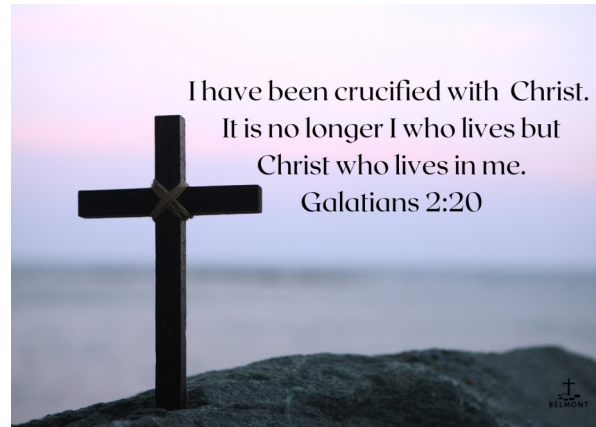
the cross and also to consider afresh the essential Jesus. We will think afresh about images and words that Jesus used to describe the purpose of his death and resurrection. This is good news!
